Over the years we have seen many members use this creative freedom to craft what we refer to as "Awareness Kits". The most commonly used method of displaying an awareness upon a set of armor often comes about in the paint job. Using the colors of a particular awareness as the primary paint scheme.

I recently had the pleasure of reaching out to two Mandos who are leading the charge in our community for Breast Cancer Awareness. With October being breast cancer awareness month we thought what better time than to do our part and help spread the awareness by giving



a voice to these two Mandalorians. Welcome Adjutant General Druj Jes and Ruus'alor/ App Team/ PR Team member Midge.

BRTTLECRY: What inspired you to want to build an awareness kit?

DRUJ: I had heard of others that had done various types of awareness kits before, and this particular cause has impacted me greatly.

mpca: I saw Droxo from Raquor daan Clan post some photos on his social media of his bright





pink kit and asked him about it. At the time my mother had recently finished nearly 2 years of treatment for Breast Cancer and it was a kit and a cause that really struck close

to home. Not only was I going to be joining group build with a wonderful group of people, I was going to be able to use that kit to bring awareness to a cause that was very important to me.

**BATTLECRY:** What does this pink armor mean to you?

me is for breast cancer awareness. Both of my grandmothers and my mother-in-law have had breast cancer.

My mom's mom has



passed, but my dad's mom and my mother-inlaw are survivors. These are just the women in my immediate family affected. I wear all of their names on my kit in gold.

Shortly after I built my kit, my sister was also diagnosed with breast cancer and underwent treatment. Thankfully, both my mother and my sister persevered, weathered the treatments and surgeries, and have been declared cancer free, but during this journey I have met others who's loved ones have not been so lucky. It is an honor to carry my family members name on my kit and it is a privilege to be able to bring awareness to this cause feeling like the entirety of the MMCC is behind me as I do.

**BRTTLECRY:** What troops have you done in this armor?

**DRUJ:** I have done a total of 3 troops in this kit since getting it approved in May. One on May 4th at a local comic shop, Joliet Star Wars Day in June, and a Susan G Komen 5K fundraiser walk raising over \$1000 for the charity.

midge: Last year I traveled to Philadelphia to walk with a group made up of members from Rancor, Mav Oya'la, and Raquor'daan in the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer walk. Our team was able to raise almost \$6,000 dollars that went to support cancer awareness and research. I am looking at a couple more events like that in 2026 that I want to get a team together to fundraise and

walk. In addition to Breast Cancer events I have worn the pink kit at Dayton Ohio's Pride event, not only did the kit fit in with the vibrant colors of the event, it prompted people to come up and ask me about it giving me the opportunity to talk about the MMCC and our Breast Cancer fundraising efforts.

**BRTTLECRY:** Do you see this pink Mando movement growing in the future?

unfortunate reality is that many of us have been impacted by breast cancer, be it a friend, loved one, or even being a patient. This disease has not been cured yet, but

every day treatments get better, and we inch closer and closer to a cure.

Clan that have expressed interest in not only become supporters and participants in fundraising efforts, but to build bright pink kits of their own. So many people that I have talked to have stories of loss and survival that revolve around this form of cancer. It touches so many lives that it is nearly impossible to find someone without a personal story or a story of a close friend or relative affected by this disease.



**BATTLECRY:** How can people support the cause?

**DRUJ:** Join a walk if you are able, you don't have to have a pink kit to support. You can add or swap parts if you want to add a splash of pink. If you are not able to walk, donate. There are several of us that do these walks at least once a year.

Buy merch – Rancor has a shirt in the store; Protectors of Lothal have a patch in the store, and are doing a Silent Auction.

midge: Simply... Join us. Whether you build a kit, walk in a team, or donate to those who put themselves out there to raise money. We do have a positive impact, my mother's treatment was a study funded by organizations like Susan G. Komen, so what we do matters. Every little bit and every single step.

### THE HIGH REPUBLIC

### AN INTERVIEW WITH AUTHOR: ZORAIDA CORDOVA

During FanX (The Salt Lake Comic Convention) last month, I was able to sit down with Zoraida Cordova the author of several Star Wars Novels including Convergence: The High Republic, (Phase 2), as well as a contributor to the Star Wars anthology Star Wars: From a Certain Point of View

BATTLECRY: Thank you for sitting down with me this evening, I usually like to start with this question, how were you introduced to Star Wars? ZORAJDA CORDOYA: I was introduced to Star Wars probably through my mom and my uncle. So I was born in Ecuador and my uncle used to watch Star Wars over there, back then, and so when we emigrated to the United States, to New York City, It always was there. My younger brother and I used to play-act Star Wars. It was the only way to get him to go to school, when he was a kid, and so it just became part of our morning routine, like, we would pop in the movie, and the music would come on, and would play-act like, or he would be like, "I'm Luke Skywalker and you're Jabba the Hutt," of course, little brothers. Then my mom had a coworker who gifted us all of his toys. He had this box of random Star Wars action figures, and the planes, or ships, and the Tie-Fighters, and everything, and so it was just a part of our everyday life.

**EATTLECRY:** Now, how did you begin writing? **ZORAJDA:** I started writing when I was thirteen years old. My teacher gave us an assignment to write three pages for extra credit, and I wrote twenty-one pages that nobody asked for. So, basically, after that assignment, I caught the bug, and I found a book that was published by a major



publisher, and they had published an author who was fourteen-years-old who was writing vampire novels, before *Twilight*. And I saw that book, and saw that it was written by a girl who was my age, writing novels that were being published, so I spent the next ten years trying to figure out how to be an author. I went to University for it, I went to a writing camp hosted by the National Writing Foundation, for two summers while I was in High School, I dropped out of college to intern at a literary agency to see how the process is made, and then decided that I didn't want to be and agent, I wanted to be a writer.

**BATTLECRY:** So, I kind of, stalked you on GoodReads, and I see that you've written far more than Star Wars.

**ZORFIDH:** Yes, I have twenty-three novels **ERTTLECRY:** Wow, that's quite a body of work, how were you brought into the Star Wars Universe as a writer?

ZDRAJDA: As a writer, I kind of have my own origin story, where I posted something, kind of, saucy about Poe Dameron on Twitter and the next day my agent gets an email from somebody at Star Wars - el Rey asking if I would want to contribute to the Star Wars anthology, From a Certain Point of View, Celebrating Forty Years of

Star Wars. She didn't say that she did it because she found my Tweet, she did mention that she had read some of my previous work, but in my head, it was really that Tweet.

BATTLECRY: Now, I did want to ask you about A Certain Point of View, the story you wrote as You Owe Me a Ride, about the Tonnika Sisters, now, when you're writing a short story about some characters that are literally on the screen for five seconds, how do you go about doing that? **ZORFIDE:** I rewatched that movie so many times, and kept rewinding and I was like, wow, they are really just there for five seconds. So what I ended up doing was, I looked up where they were referenced in other places, and I'm pretty sure they were in Tales from Jabba's Palace, maybe, one of those Legends books, and I saw that they were linked to Han and Lando as, like, paramours in the past, and so, I kind of went with that and I had the idea that they were going to try to lift his car [the Millennium Falcon] as a kind of vengeance kind of thing. Or pay back, ya know? Of course they don't get to do it. I was really nervous writing for it, the first time, because I wasn't sure what I was allowed to do, and then, the more I wrote for Star Wars, the more I got comfortable with pitching the wildest things and seeing if they'll allow me to do it.

ERTTLECRY: Ok, let's go back a few years to The High Republic.

ZORRIDA: Three-hundred years

ERTTLECRY: Thank you, Three-hundred years, was there source material for you?

ZORRIDE: So there are two different eras of the High Republic, and I wasn't one of the original architects of the High Republic. I came in, in the second phase. So, there are three phases... we basically did: the [original] trilogy, the prequels, and the sequels. So, we did the same thing, we went further back in time and then back to the present. So, because there was no lore, what we ended up doing was in phase one, there were five authors, Caven Scott, Justina Ireland, Charles Soule,

Claudia Gray, and Daniel José Older, and the five of them became the architects of the project. They laid down the groundwork of what the High Republic was going to look like, what do the Jedi believe at this point, for who's in the council, for who were their enemies, because we don't have the Sith yet. From there, once they started working on the second phase, we expanded a little bit, I got to create my own characters, and I was brought into that initiative through Mike Siglain, who is the creative director for LucasFilm [Publishing] and, they had their own ideas of, like, what they wanted to do with going further back in time three-hundred years into the High Republic and created new villains and new challenges for the Jedi to handle. You know, they had to make it up, and then of course, borrow from the original books, so you'll see references or easter eggs within the story.

**EFITTLECRY**: Now that I know you're from Ecuador, um... as an English Major, I studied Latin-American authors a bit, and there is a tradition of "Magical Realism," do you bring that tradition in, at all, to Star Wars?

**ZORFIDH**: You know, it's interesting that you ask that, because this is actually my Magical Realism book, it's called *The Inheritance of Orquidea Divina*, but when it came to Star Wars, there's an

aspect to my main character, Gella, and Gella's relationship to the Force, I wrote my own, sort of myth, of what happens to the Jedi when they lose their path, and I think that creating my own mythology, that really comes from that tradition. It's very small because Magical Realism doesn't fit in the Star Wars world, right? Because it's space opera.



### SOCIAL ZOCIETIES OF THE WWCC

Even though the Mando Mercs Costume club itself is a very social group, over the course of the years of the club's existence different groups have come together to deepen their bonds of friendship based on shared experiences and interests. Taking a look at the forums you can see that the foundation of the Social Societies began back in 2013 as a segment of the forums set aside for "fun groups" as the Mandalore dubbed them

then. At the time these groups were not recognized as anything official, but were supported as positive outlets and a way to strengthen the

growing Mando Mercs community.

Fast forward 12 years and you will find the Social Societies are one of the most active sections of our forums. They have grown to the point where there are now several formal societies that have been recognized by the club for their missions and membership. These groups all have their own livery, sigils, and regalia that are approved to be worn on MMCC official kits. I think the Mandalore summed up the formal societies very well in the purpose statement in the Social Societies charter. The purpose of the Social Societies is "to create societal communities within the MMCC that connect club members through shared life experiences, elevating the overall culture of the club and creating safe spaces that promote personal growth and community support."

For a society to become a formal society requires that a group be active on the forums for a total of 6 months, that they elect among their members a Keeper that is responsible for maintaining a society roster, they put in writing their doctrine or purpose, and have at least 15 members. They must choose an Icon that directly reflects their purpose, and they must devise a sigil under which its members operate. Going through this petition process allows the society to take advantage of being able to produce and sell livery items through the MMCC store that can be offered to club membership worldwide to support fund raisers for charity or the various charitable funds through the club. They also get their

very own section of the forums, specifically dedicated to that society's business.

The MMCC currently has a total of 9 formal societies that span a wide range of interests and purpose: The Aran Wolves Oyula Ori'tsad- This society is dedicated to those MMCC members who identify with wolves or display wolf based sigils on their approved kits.

Beta Brigade: Diabetics of Mandalore- Dedicated to

those members of who are either diabetic or who support someone who is. A place of camaraderie and support for all those who deal with blood sugar related issues.

Cabur Akaata (Protector Battalion)- Dedicated to those brave warriors who have in some way served in the military (past or present)

The Grey Brigade and OT guard- This society is a place for those who are over 40 and had the potential to watch the original trilogy in theaters. Here they celebrate age and costuming, building camaraderie through their life experience.

THE BEGINNING: A FOUNDLING IS BORN

Kotep Dral's journey with the Mandalorian Mercs began on November 7, 2016, when he was officially recognized as a Foundling. This marked the start of a transformative path that would see him evolve from a novice into a respected and influential member of the community. The Mandalorian Mercs, known for their strict adherence to the Mandalorian Creed and their immersive approach to Star Wars costuming and culture, provided the perfect environment for Kotep to channel his love for Star Wars into a meaningful and impactful endeavor.

#### THE ARMOR: A LABOR OF LOVE

The forging of Mandalorian armor is a rite of passage, symbolizing the wearer's dedication and craftsmanship. For Kotep Dral, this process was a labor of love that spanned from 2017 to 2020. His role here was crucial, as he helped new members navigate their initial steps within the Mando Mercs. His experience and insight made him an invaluable asset, and in early 2023, he was promoted to Team Lead for the Welcome Team, which had been renamed the Foundling Guides. The most rewarding experience in Kotep Dral's journey with the Mandalorian Mercs came on Star Wars Day in 2023. Arqet Clan partnered with Disney/Lucasfilm to induct a Make-a-Wish beneficiary, Connor, into the clan. This heartwarming event saw Arqet Clan providing

Connor with his own Mandalorian armor, while Lucasfilm contributed a video message and a signed Boba Fett helmet from Temuera Morrison. ### WILDLIFE OF MANDALORE

The 2001 book The Wildlife of Star Wars explored the ecosystems of various planets in-depth - unfortunately, Mandalore was not among them, but throughout Star Wars media, since the very first appearance of the planet in 1981's Marvel Star Wars issue 68, we have had some glimpses of the fauna native to the homeworld in both Legends and Canon.

#### **MYTHOSAUR**

Of course, the most famous of all of Mandalore's beasts is the feared mythosaur. A draconic organism of titanic proportions, some so gigantic that their bones became the basis for Mandalore's first cities. When the Taung ancestors of the Mandalorians first reached their new homeworld, the hunting of the mythosaurs was performed as the symbol of their conquest of the planet. Eventually, they were driven extinct - or so it was believed. The skull of the mythosaur became the signet of Clan Keldau, and eventually became

#### **STRILL**

Even among the varied fauna of the galaxy far far away, the strill was truly unique. Hexapodal, hermaphroditic, semi-sapient, capable of gliding, and able to live for several centuries, strills were often used as hunting companions by Mandalorians, until they sadly became critically endangered. The strill named Lord Mirdalan was the beloved pet of Walon Vau in the Republic Commando novel series.

#### TRINITAUR

At 196 meters in length, the trinitaur is a colossal animal, easily able to be considered a kaiju. It was seen attacking the langskib of the Great Purge's survivors in Chapter 23 of The Mandalorian. Fun fact out-of-universe: the 3D model of the Trinitaur was created by ILM using CG assets for the Ankylosaurus in the Jurassic World films.

#### SHRIEK-HAWK

The second most important creature to Mandalorian culture is undoubtedly the Shriek-Hawk. Two pieces of prevalent iconography derive from the reptavian - the symbol of the Jaig Eyes, the greatest honor a warrior can be bestowed, derives its etymology from Jai'galaar, the Mando'a name for the animal. The other is the sigil of Clan Vizsla, and in turn the Death Watch, which depicts it mid-dive.

The Vizsla Shriek-Hawk sigil is proudly displayed on Kar'tayl Ani of Kyrimorut Clan

#### DARK SIDE OF THE APPLES

#### Ingredients:

12 small Apples
12 sticks (Chop Sticks work well)
3 cups Sugar
1/2 cup Light Corn Syrup
1 cup Water
1/2 tsp Red Food Coloring

#### Directions:

- 1. Wash Apples. Grocery Stores will often put wax on the fruit to make them shiny. Use a weak solution of water and white vinegar to get the way off.
- 2. Combine Sugar, Corn Syrup, and Water in a saucepan over medium heat.
- 3. Bring to boil. Use a thermometer and heat to 300 F.
- 4. Add Food Coloring and stir to combine.
- 5. Dip Apples, swirl to coat.
- 6. Let excess sugar solution drip into pan.
- 7. Place on Parchment Paper to cool.
