



NEO CRUSADER

The Neo-Crusaders waged brutal warfare against the Galactic Republic during the Mandalorian Wars. Standardized armor and color-coded ranks reflected their disciplined, militaristic vision, designed for function and recognized across the galaxy. This style calls wearers to stand as a unified front, grounded in shared purpose and strength.

SOFT PARTS



Soft costume elements from other eras are prohibited.

FLAK VEST & FLIGHT SUIT

- Fully "sealed" flight suit is required (no visible skin). A neck seal is required if the collar does not fully cover the neck.
- Flightsuits are form fitting with added structure and detail to provide more weight and visual depth.

BELT & AMMO POUCHES

- At least one of the following:
 - Ammo Belt
 - Girth Belt
 - Waist Sash
 - Holster Belt



OTHER SOFT PARTS

- Full-fingered gloves are required.
- Half capes and kamas can be worn in addition to but not in lieu of required coverage.
- Half capes and kamas must be black, white, or match armor color.



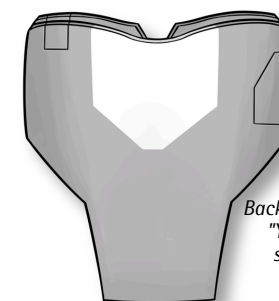
HELMET

- Mandalorian helmet from Neo-Crusader Era required.
- Hard faceplate and helmet, covered by a soft, flexible cowl of the same color.



BACK COVERING

- Single piece hard back covering is required. Including, but not limited to: back armor, backpacks, air tanks, or jet packs.



Backplates are "Y" or "T" shaped.

GAUNTLETS

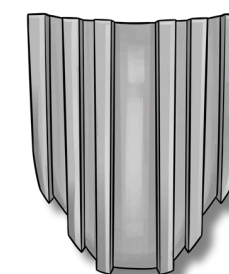
- Gauntlets should be of simple geometric designs and fully enclose the arm.
- Armored hand plates are required.

LOWER BODY

- Padded or hard cod cover is required.
- Shin armor is required. Full enclosure shin armor is encouraged, but not required.
- Thigh armor is encouraged, but not required.

HELMET LIST



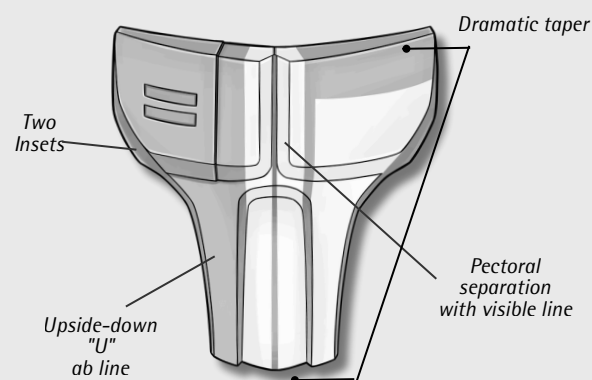
ARMOR COLOR GUIDE

Armor must be painted red, blue, silver, or gold with white detailing, to match references. All pieces should share the same base color.



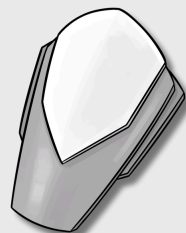
CHEST ARMOR

- One-piece chest armor with ab plate, styled to dramatically taper inwards from pectorals to ab. It should also include the following characteristics:



KOTOR Chest

- Shoulder bells feature a layered look with at least 2 layers for depth.

Armor styles from other eras are prohibited.
