Post-Imp Chest Armor Guide

COVERT

Covert style permits customized chest armor case by case. It is more flexible in style, but must still be based on canon plates.

MERCENARY

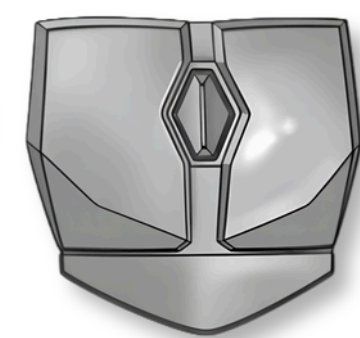
Mercenary style requires chest armor to closely match the on-screen references for shape and fit.

SURVIVOR

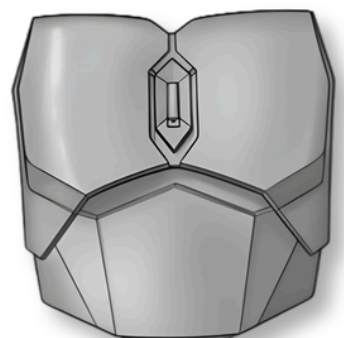
Survivor style does permit limited customizations. The chest armor should be immediately recognizable from its canon source.

MASTER

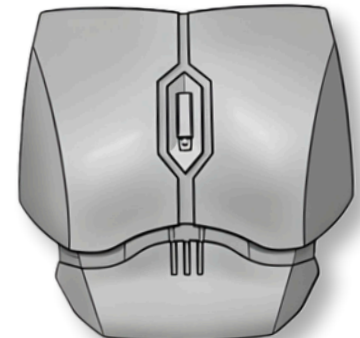
Chest armor that is approvable for the covert style will be approvable in the master style.



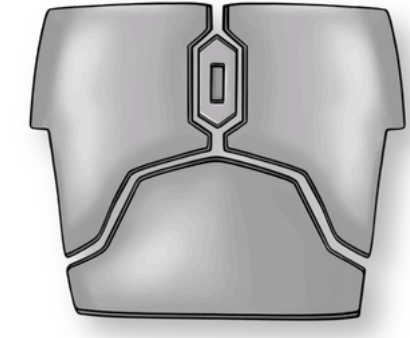

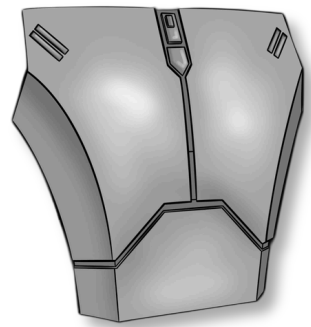

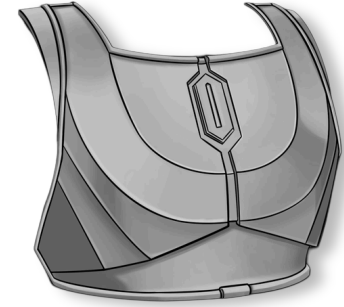

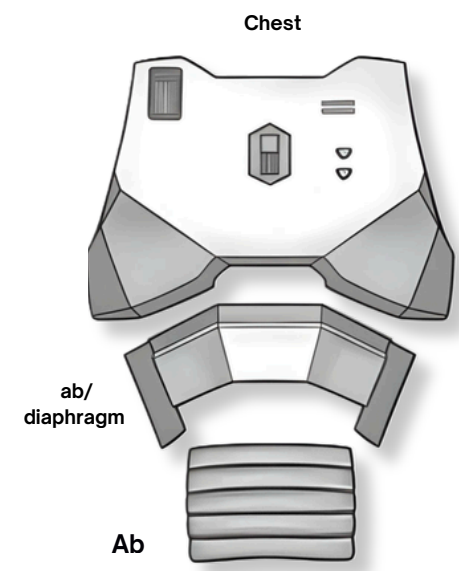

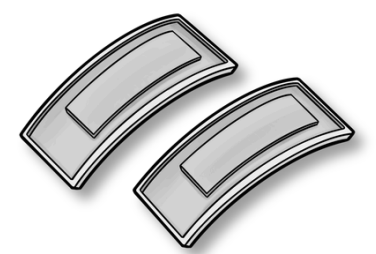
