This style channels the timeless look of Boba Fett's armor as first seen in the Original Trilogy. Next to their iconic helmets, Modern Mandalorians are best known for their evenly spaced chest armor. This versatile style of armor features unique opportunities to create armor designs that can be as simplistic or as elaborate as desired.

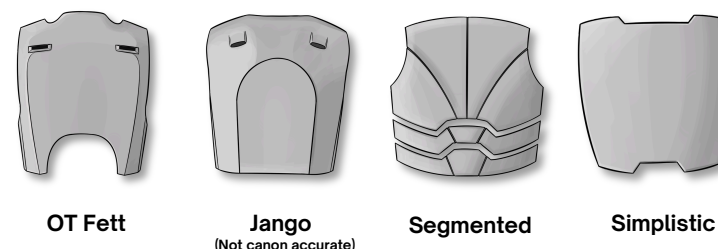
HELMET LIST

HELMET

- Custom Modern and Post-Imperial style helmets (check Helmet Reference Images).
- At least 2/3 of T-visor must be visible. "T" shape required.

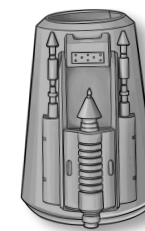
BACK COVERING

- A hard backplate or other armored cover, such as a hard backpack, jetpack, air tank, etc. is required that covers 2/3 the overall width and length of the back.
- Top of the backplate cannot extend past the width of the collar plate.
- Capes, dusters, jetpacks, and hard backpacks can be used in lieu of an armored back covering if they fully conceal the lack of a backplate.
- Soft backpacks must be used with a hard backplate.



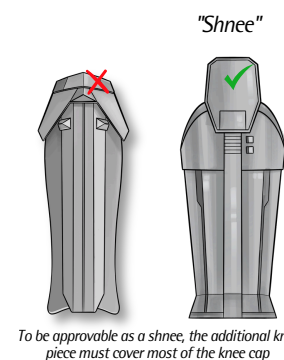
GAUNTLETS

- Armor or rigid covering on the forearms. Including, but not limited to: Gauntlets, hard bracers, or armored gloves.



LOWER BODY

- Both knees and a cod piece are the minimum.
- Soft cod or a loincloth can be used instead of a hard cod piece.
- "Shnees" (knee + shin combo) are an acceptable variant for knees.

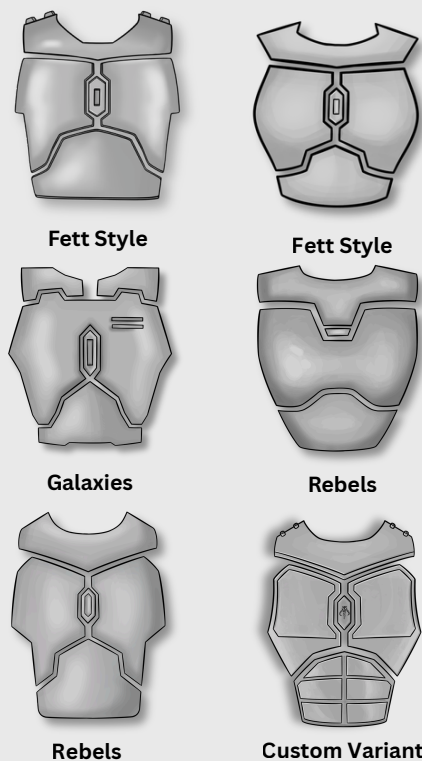


To be approvable as a shnee, the additional knee piece must cover most of the knee cap



CHEST ARMOR

- Consists of properly spaced collar plate, chest plates, a chest diamond, and abdomen plate. Custom styles are allowed.
- Shoulders can be custom or Fett style. Double plates permitted.



SOFT PARTS



FLAK VEST & FLIGHT SUIT

- Vests may be traditional Fett style or custom style. (Shoulder caps are optional.)
- Short-sleeved flight suits are allowed if worn with gauntlets.

BELT & AMMO POUCHES

- Must have two of the following:
 - 1) Ammo or holster belt
 - 2) Girth belt or waist sash

OTHER SOFT PARTS

- Full fingered or fingerless gloves.
- Dusters, capes, and ponchos are allowed.
- Kamas can be worn, but are not required.
