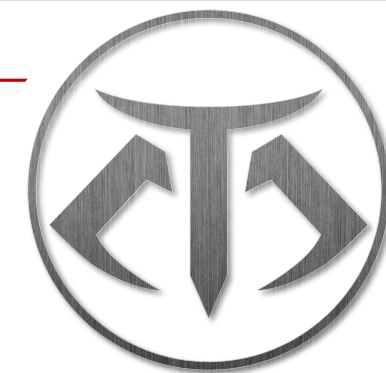

BEAST HUNTER FEATURES

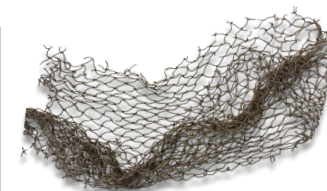
- **Colors:** Colors should be natural in tone and appropriate for the environment in which the Hunter operates. Camo and earth-tone palettes are strongly encouraged.
- **Weathering:** Heavy weathering is required. Effects may include scratches, claw marks, bite marks, dirt, mud, worn edges, and other signs of frequent encounters with dangerous wildlife.
- **Soft Parts:** All soft goods should have the appearance of natural materials.

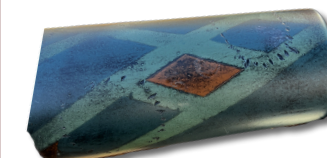
