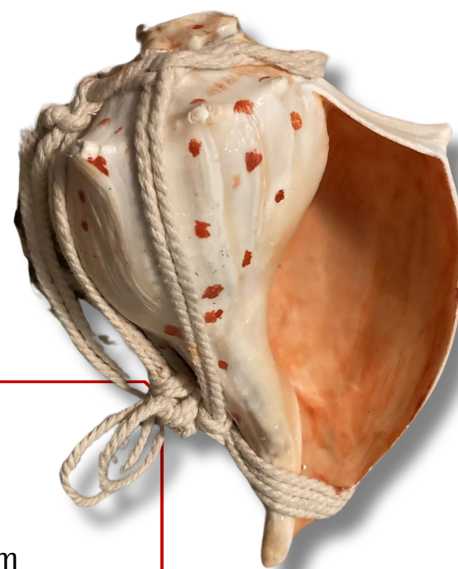

Aquatic Ops blends into their watery environment with primarily grays, blues, and teals with minimal blacks, browns, and tans.



Aquatic kits require signs of underwater wear, including coral rash, scrapes, and similar abrasion. Loose debris and surface dust should be absent, having been washed away.

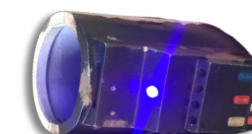
