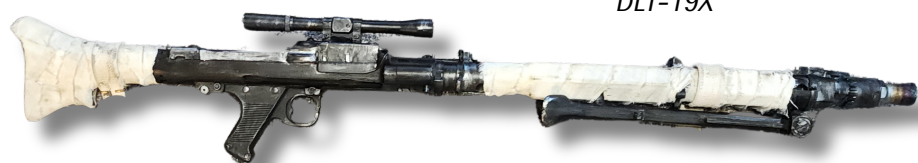
BRIGADES

MMCC Brigades represents a distinct set of professions, with specific costume requirements known as Brigade Requirement Lists (BRLs). Members wishing to join a brigade must meet both CRL and BRL requirements to apply for recognition.

ARCTIC WEAPONS

In the shifting snow of the arctic landscape, having a carbine or rifle that ranges over the vast open spaces is essential. Keeping that weapon from freezing is often a struggle; the frigid temperatures mean that weapons must have minimal moving parts or a key heating element to keep it functional.

A bladed weapon is an essential tool for any Mando striving to stay alive in the arctic.

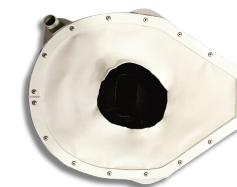
The arctic kit should be lightly to heavily weathered and should have very little exposed “metal”.

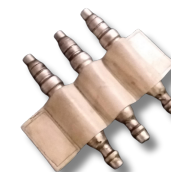
