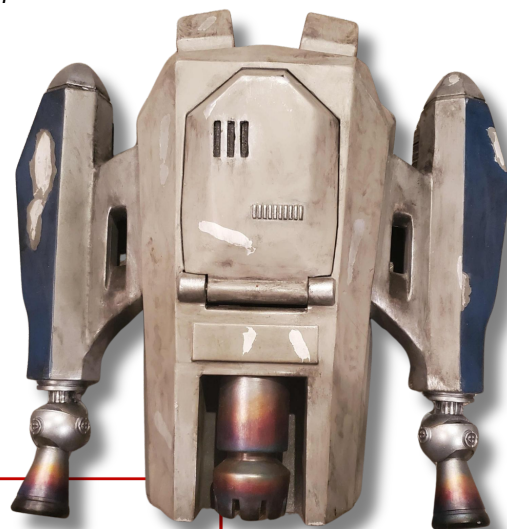

SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT

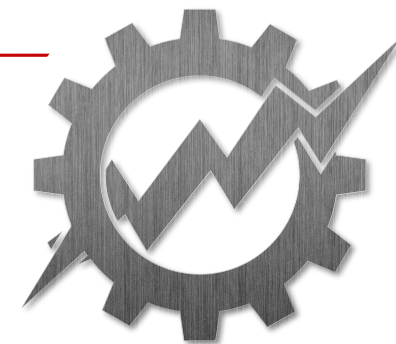
Vibro Knife

Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, back, cod/armored loin cloth, shoulders, gauntlets, and knees. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

MOBILE ENGINEER FEATURES

- **Helmet:** A visible data port is required, along with a compatible interface device such as a data-pad or gauntlet.
- **Weathering:** light to heavy. Weathering must be consistent and realistic to the environment.
- **Colors:** Combat Slicers must employ subdued colors. Bright or highly conspicuous color schemes are not appropriate for battlefield operations.

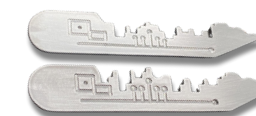
