



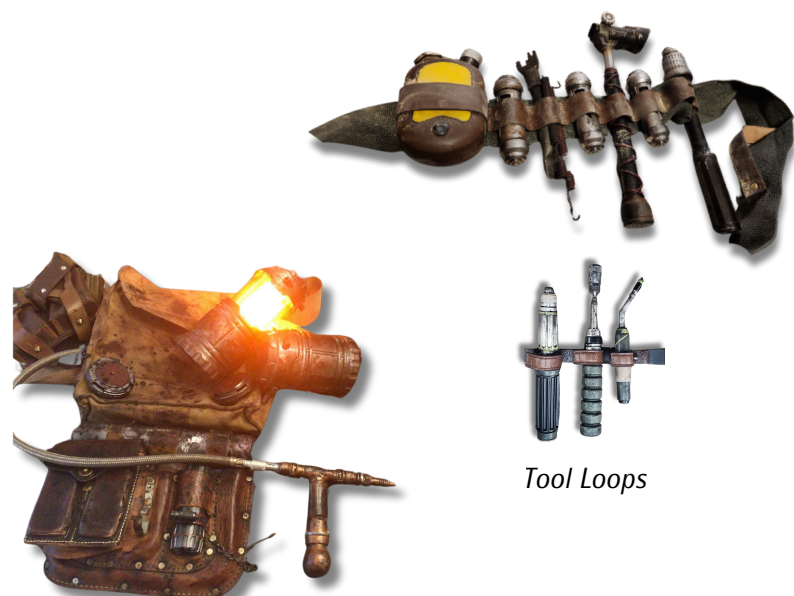

BRIGADES

MMCC Brigades represents a distinct set of professions, with specific costume requirements known as Brigade Requirement Lists (BRLs). Members wishing to join a brigade must meet both CRL and BRL requirements to apply for recognition.

Mechanics are the masters of battlefield repair and improvisation. With the right tools (or sometimes just a box of scraps), they can restore damaged gear, vehicles, or weapons to fighting shape, keeping the mission alive when it matters most.

TOOL BAGS

Mechanics carry tool bags, pouches, and utility loops to keep critical equipment close at hand. Their storage systems should accommodate the tools and replacement components needed to return damaged gear to service.

WEAPONS

Mechanics favor practical, dependable sidearms that won't interfere with their work. Compact blasters provide reliable protection while leaving room for the tools.



Custom Blasters

Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, back, cod/armored loin cloth, shoulders, gauntlets, and knees. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

MOBILE ENGINEER FEATURES

- Weathering: Heavy weathering is required. Grease stains, oil residue, grime, worn armor surfaces, minor burn marks, carbon scoring, and similar effects should reflect the demands of maintenance and repair work.
- Colors: No color restrictions apply.
