MMCC Brigades represents a distinct set of professions, with specific costume requirements known as Brigade Requirement Lists (BRLs). Members wishing to join a brigade must meet both CRL and BRL requirements to apply for recognition.

Pistoleers are the quick-draw artists of the Mandalorian ranks: fast, stylish, and deadly accurate with their pistols. Pistoleers move with a unique confidence and flair, able to take down targets in rapid succession before holstering their blasters with a flourish. They are often underestimated and just as often the last thing their enemies see.

PISTOLEER WEAPONS

Pistoleers must carry a pair of easily accessible, one-handed blasters. These weapons are often a matched set, though some Pistoleers prefer blasters with different capabilities. Both blasters must be customized to reflect the wearer's personal style.

WEAPONS

Throwing knives are the hidden surprise of these blaster experts.



Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, back, cod/armored loin cloth, shoulders, gauntlets, and knees. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

ARMOR

PISTOLEER FEATURES

- Armor: Must be light or medium to allow for quick movement while providing protection.
- Helmet: A rangefinder is required.
- Gauntlets: Must maintain a low-profile design that does not restrict movement.
- Soft Parts: A sash may be worn in place of a girth belt but must meet all applicable BRL requirements.
- Weathering: Must be consistent across the entire kit, including all armor and soft parts.
