



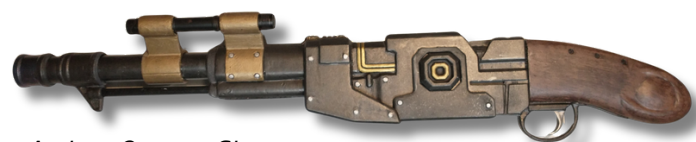

MMCC Brigades represents a distinct set of professions, with specific costume requirements known as Brigade Requirement Lists (BRLs). Members wishing to join a brigade must meet both CRL and BRL requirements to apply for recognition.

URBAN ASSAULT WEAPONS

Urban combat requires a balance of function and practicality. A short, two-handed blaster provides range, portability, and maneuverability between buildings. Long rifles and sniper rifles are not permitted.

Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, boot, shin, knee, thigh, cod, shoulder, back, and gauntlet armor. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

URBAN ASSAULT FEATURES

- Colors: Muted colors suited to blending in with urban environments, such as: black, gray, dull white, brick red, brown, or similar industrial tones.
- Weathering: Must be consistent with urban combat damage, such as: dust, soot, scrapes, chipping, concrete abrasion, and blast-related damage.
- Shoulder Armor: Must maintain a low-profile silhouette. Oversized or bulky shoulder plates are not permitted.
- Capes: only a short, single-shoulder cape may be worn.
