PILOTS WEAPONS

While the ship's guns provide the primary line of defense, there are times when a pilot must leave the vessel. For this reason, Mando pilots carry a holstered one-handed blaster compact enough to fit within the limited space of the cockpit.

Short, two-handed blasters may fit within the cockpit and provide a downed pilot with additional range.

Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, back, cod/armored loin cloth, shoulders, gauntlets, and knees. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

PILOTS FEATURES

- Weathering: Must appear consistent and realistic for combat use.
- Helmets: Must feature hoses and a reinforced forehead area. Any greeblies must maintain a low-profile design. Rangefinders, antennas, and other attachments that protrude above the helmet dome are prohibited.
- Softs: The flightsuit must feature flap-closure pouch pockets on the front of the thighs or Boba-style thigh pouches.
