



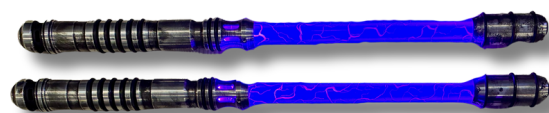

DROID HUNTER WEAPONS

Droid Hunters must often bring down rogue droids without destroying them entirely. For this purpose, ion blasters, EMP weapons and electro staffs are the preferred weapons of choice.

Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, boot, shin, knee, thigh, cod, shoulder, bicep, back, and gauntlet armor. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

DROID HUNTER FEATURES

- Weathering: Must feature heavy combat weathering consistent with repeated engagements against droids, such as: scorch marks, heavy impact points, blaster damage, gouges, dents, and other clearly droid-inflicted wear.
- Weapons: Vibro weapons may be used as a primary weapon when they measure at least 2 feet (61 cm) in length.
