MMCC Brigades represents a distinct set of professions, with specific costume requirements known as Brigade Requirement Lists (BRLs). Members wishing to join a brigade must meet both CRL and BRL requirements to apply for recognition.

HEAVY ASSAULT WEAPONS

These frontline fighters carry weapons to match their role. Whether dual-wielding heavy one-handed blasters or pairing a riot shield with a blaster shotgun, these armored tanks are equipped to drive the front line forward.

Custom Blasters

Minimum required armor includes collar, chest, abdomen, boot, shin, knee, thigh, cod, shoulder, back, and gauntlet armor. Era-specific requirements apply regardless of which BRL is selected.

HEAVY ASSAULT FEATURES

- Weathering: Must feature realistic combat damage.
- Helmet Equipment: Rangefinders and antennas are permitted but must be sturdier than standard versions. Ear-mounted cannons and blasters are also permitted.
- Gauntlets: Each gauntlet must feature at least one offensive system, such as a flamethrower, retractable blade, missile, or similar weapon.
- Gloves: Fingerless gloves are not permitted.
